International collaborations

We've begun talks with Ecoprod, the organization behind Eurimages' sustainable filmmaking elearning platform. As we work to promote ecofriendly filmmaking in Türkiye, we're also aiming to extend our efforts globally, reaching a wider audience and increasing co-production opportunities.

We've kicked off exciting conversations with academics, professionals, and national film commissions leading sustainable film and media initiatives across Europe!





Training programs

We joined the Climate Adaptation for Creatives online training, organized by the British Council and Black Mountains College. The program presents participants the chance to explore how art can create positive change in the face of the ecological crisis.

We also attended the *Türkiye-Germany Green Film Experience Sharing Project* workshop, organized by Başkent University's CIRC with support from the Turkish Ministry of Culture and Tourism's General Directorate of Cinema and the Goethe Institute Ankara. Alongside experts from Germany, we shared ideas and experiences on sustainable filmmaking.

We've participated in seminars and training programs from leading international organizations such as BAFTA albert, AdGreen, ReelGreen, BBC Academy, and the International Screen Institute.









Awarded "Green Initiative of the Year"!

We won the Green Initiative of the Year award at the 4th Boğaziçi Environment Awards, hosted by Boğaziçi University's Electrotechnology Club (BUEC IEEE).



Launching the training programs!

We've completed the preparation of our sustainable filmmaking training programs for professionals, educators, and students. The pilot sessions of the training modules, developed with experts from Brunel University London and Birmingham University, will take place in 2025. The first training for university students will be held online with Yapımlab on February 15-16.





Over the past year, we participated in many impressive events.



As part of the Sabancı Foundation's 8th Short Film Competition, we hosted a panel with Korhan Uğur and Kiraz Erdem, the sustainable production managers of the Turkish films *Once Upon a Time in the Future: 2121* and *Neandria*.



We shared our insights on international collaborations and educational opportunities at the Higher Education Dialogues Workshop: UK-Türkiye Transnational Education Partnerships, organized by the British Council Türkiye.

We gave a seminar on "Sustainability and Ecology in Film and Media Productions" at İzmir Yaşar University.

In collaboration with Yapımlab, we organized online seminars to reach a broader audience. During these sessions, we explored the key principles of sustainable filmmaking with examples from both Türkiye and around the world.



We took part in the "The Climate of Art" interview series on the Co-Climate platform, aimed at raising motivation in the fight against climate change.

In collaboration with the Turkish British Centre for Cultural and Creative Industries, we hosted a panel titled "Sustainable Film Production and a Case Study: *Neandria*" at the London Yunus Emre Institute, following a screening of Reha Erdem's *Neandria* (2023).





We visited Brunel University London, an educational partner of BAFTA albert, and took part in a workshop on sustainable filmmaking education.



At the International Environmental Humanities Conference at Cappadocia University, we discussed raising ecological awareness in film production and advancing sustainable filmmaking.

We presented the Platform's work and shared examples from Türkiye at the conference organized by the European Network for Cinema and Media Studies.



We also evaluated climate crisis and environmental awareness projects at Green for Youth: Youth Movement for Sustainability, a platform created by high school students from across Türkiye.

At the Adana Golden Boll Film Festival, we participated in a panel on sustainable filmmaking. In the session "Sustainability in Cinema Ecosystems and Eco-Cinema," we discussed sustainable filmmaking alongside experts from Çukurova University and the Cinema-TV Union.





We prepared a comprehensive recommendation report for Istanbul Film Station, aligned with the UN Sustainable Development Goals.

At the 25th International İzmir Short Film Festival, we presented on sustainable filmmaking as part of the festival program.



We participated in a seminar organized by the Environmental and Climate Society at Ankara Hacı Bayram Veli University, where we discussed climate storytelling in films and TV series.
